## Annual Provider Status Reports (APSR)

Providers with IPRS contracts should complete their APSR as soon as possible, if you have not already done so. The report, which can be accessed by clicking [here](#), should be completed by an agency's Executive Director or other designated individual. Contracts for next fiscal year CANNOT be issued until the report is submitted.

## IPRS Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Billing Submission Deadlines

Service Dates July 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011

The deadline for submission of IPRS claims to OPC with service dates July 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011 was 5 pm on Tuesday, June 14, in order for the claims to bill to the state on June 16. It is now too late to submit IPRS claims for this timespan.

Service Dates May 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011

The deadline for May and June services is Tuesday, July 26 at 5pm. Providers are strongly encouraged to submit these IPRS claims to OPC by Monday, July 18 in order to allow time to check "status" of claims submitted, identify any errors that require correction in order to bill to IPRS, make those corrections, and resubmit the claims prior to the July 26 deadline.

Please share these IPRS claims submission deadlines with the billing staff at your agency.

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## **Request For Application: Child Mental Health Funds for Parent Training and Education**

OPC Area Program is releasing a Request for Application for parenting education and training programs in Person County. **The funding of these projects is dependent on receiving funding from the state and is not guaranteed. Funds available will not exceed \$7,000.**

### **Target Population:**

Youth over the age of three and under the age of 18 years and their families. Parenting education and training should be geared toward families and children with social/emotional/behavioral challenges and/or multiple risk factors including involvement with social services or juvenile court.

**Note:** These funds must be used by June 30, 2012. Winning applicants will invoice OPC Area Program for expenses and provide periodic updates to the Person Collaborative on progress of the projects.
