Emergency Shelter

Orange County

- Inter-Faith Council (IFC) Community House - (919)967-0643. Provides emergency housing to approximately 30 men. Location: 100 W. Rosemary St., Chapel Hill.
- Inter-Faith Council Homestart- (919) 932-6025. Provides emergency shelter to women and children. Location: 2505 Homestead Rd., Chapel Hill.

Chatham County

- Silk Hope Catholic Worker - (919) 663-4334. Provides temporary housing to a limited number of women, children, and families. Location: Siler City. Individuals must have transportation due to location.
- Family Promise – Faythe Canson – (919) 370-6983- Emergency housing for families and individuals (starting November 2011)

Transitional Housing

Orange County

- **IFC Homestart** - (919) 932-6025. In addition to emergency shelter, Homestart offers transitional housing (longer term) to women and children. Location: 2505 Homestead Rd., Chapel Hill.
- **Freedom House**- (919) 942-2803. Residential treatment for single men and women with substance abuse disorders. Location: 104 New Stateside Dr., Chapel Hill.
- **UNC Horizons: Sunrise**- (919)966-9803. Residential treatment for women with children or pregnant women and with substance abuse disorders. Please call for availability.

Permanent Housing

Orange County

- **Orange County Housing and Community Development**- (919)245-2490 or (919) 969-3016. The Housing Voucher Choice program, otherwise known as Section 8, provides rental subsidies to individuals and families at or below 50% area median income. To apply visit: 300 West Tryon St., Hillsborough or 2501 Homestead Rd., Chapel Hill.
- **Town of Chapel Hill Public Housing**- (919) 968-2850. Manages approximately 336 public housing units reserved for individuals and families at or below 80% area median income. Location: 317 Caldwell Ext., Chapel Hill.
- **CASA, Community Alternatives for Supportive Abodes**- (919) 754-9960. CASA operates several supportive housing programs in Orange County. Housing is dedicated for individuals who are homeless and/or disabled. Location:

- **Club Nova Apartments**- In addition to the daytime club house, there are 24 efficiency apartments for adults with disabilities located behind the Club Nova Clubhouse. These apartments are managed by Mental Health Association of NC. To apply for housing, one should fill out a housing application with Orange Housing and Community Development

- **Targeted Tax Credit Units** - Affordable housing for persons with disabilities. Must have disability income. For referrals, contact Stacy Hurley at DHHS (919) 401-6850.

Chatham County

- **Coalition for Family Peace - (919) 742-7320 Office.** Associated with Family Violence Prevention Center, this agency provides service linkage, assistance with court appearances, protective orders and more. Services offered in Spanish. Location: Siler City.

Person County

- **Safe Haven Person County** - (336) 597-8699- Office; (336) 599-7233 Crisis. This agency provides shelter to domestic violence victims. Location: Roxboro.
